What is collected

Maple Bluff Country Club collects Demographic, Contact Information and Images for use on our Membership Roster to enable members and the Club to communicate with each other. Maple Bluff Country Club also collects images at events which it may use on club and promotional material. By posting images on Maple Bluff Country Club Digital Platforms you consent to their use by Maple Bluff County Club for use in club and promotional material.

From time-to-time our site requests information via surveys. Participation in these surveys or contests is completely voluntary and you may choose whether or not to participate and therefore disclose this information. Information requested may include contact information and demographic information (such as name, age level). Survey information will be used for purposes of monitoring or improving the services and membership experience of the Club.

Partners
