

GOLF GUIDELINES

Dear Members,

Please know that the health and safety of our members and employees is our #1 priority. To that end and until further notice, we have implemented the following safety measures to protect everyone:

All members are subject to these common rules:

- Any member who has any symptoms of any illness is asked to please **stay home or seek medical assistance**.
- All members must practice “social distancing” within your group, and with groups outside of your own - about 6 feet.

Golf Rules

- Bag Drop is closed.
- Bag Room is closed. Clubs to be kept with members after initially retrieved.
- Golf carts are allowed. Single rider only unless you live in the same house.
- All club push golf carts will be sanitized before each use, but members are also encouraged to sanitize the handle and other touch points prior to and during play. Use personal push carts whenever possible. We may not have enough club push carts for play.
- The Pro Shop is open – limited to 5 shoppers at a time.
- Course restrooms are available. Access to locker rooms are limited.
- Water coolers, ball washers, benches and bunker rakes have been removed from the course.
- If your ball lands in a bunker, preferred lies are available. One club length and place the ball in the bunker
- Do not touch tee markers.
- Putt with the flagsticks left in the hole and do not touch. This will eliminate another common touch point. Golfers should remove only their own ball from the cup. A cup liner has been installed to keep the ball high in the hole.
- Driving Range is open. Stations will be socially distanced across the tee. Please be respectful of social distancing guidelines and respectful of your fellow members and guests in your time hitting balls. We will be monitoring usage and will incorporate a time limit if deemed necessary at a later point. Bag stands, tees, and club scrubber/towels will not be on the range to avoid additional touch points. When using the short game area, please pick up your practice balls and put them in the “Dirty Ball Basket” when you are done practicing. All balls are cleaned daily in a bleach solution.
- Putting greens are open.
- Golf Simulator is open, limit 2 people at a time.

Common Sense Reminders

- Please do not show up more than 15 minutes prior to your tee time.
- Washing hands with soap and water for at least 20 seconds as frequently as possible or using hand sanitizer;
- Covering coughs or sneezes (into the sleeve or elbow, not hands);
- Regularly clean high-touch surfaces;
- Follow all other public health recommendations issues by DHS and CDC.

Please do all you can to maintain physical distancing during your time at Maple Bluff Country Club.
